National Committee (Term through June 30th, 2021):

- **Director of Title IX **New Position****

Duties

- Serve on the Standards Board
- Oversee the Sexual Assault Prevention and Resource (SAPR) Committee
- Evaluate policies and procedures regarding Title IX
- Draft and review Title IX Fraternity statements
- Advocate for chapters currently affected by Title IX situations

Qualifications

- Title IX certification
- Must be an Alumni member in good standing with their chapter and the Fraternity
- Must have served at least one year of activeness at a chapter
- Must hold alumni status of at least four years (applies to applicants who were active as a graduate student)

- **National Historian: Now, more than ever, we need to document our Fraternity history.**

Duties

- Receive, collect and preserve materials pertaining to the Fraternity history, including founding information, important events, marketing materials and chapter milestones.
- Work with each chapter historian to ensure chapter history is maintained and the necessary information is added to the overall Fraternity history when appropriate.

- Oversee the Chapter Directors and chapters in the region and provide coaching and assistance when needed
- Assist in following up with incidents and concerns in the region
- Visit each chapter in the region at least once per year to assess the status of the chapter and provide recommendations
- Provide status on the region to the Vice President of Undergraduate Affairs
