

How to Report an Incident

Colorado State University-Pueblo

Students are encouraged to report any allegations of sexual misconduct immediately to the Pueblo Sheriff's Office (if the incident occurred on campus) or the Pueblo Police Department (if the incident occurred off campus), and to the University's Sexual Assault Response Coordinator. If an alleged incident of sexual misconduct involves a University staff or faculty member, the situation should be immediately brought to the attention of the Director of Affirmative Action & Equal Employment Opportunity.

As necessary, the University reserves the right to initiate a complaint, to serve as complainant, and to initiate conduct proceedings without a formal complaint by the victim of misconduct.

CSU-Pueblo will not tolerate intentional false reporting of incidents. It is a violation of the Code of Student Conduct and Adjudication to make an intentionally false report of any policy violation, and it may also violate state criminal statutes and civil defamation laws.
